
2025 NATIONAL JUNIOR FOLDING DISPLAY CONTEST RULES



- 1. All entrants must be Junior members of Holstein Association USA.
- 2. States may enter an unlimited number of entries. There will be three age divisions and two categories. Individuals may enter both categories. The theme must be dairy industry related.

Age divisions:

Junior: 9 to 13 years old as of January 1 Intermediate: 14 to 17 years old as of January 1 Senior: 18 to 20 years old as of January 1

Categories: Creative & Scientific

- 3. Display should be no larger than 4' x 4', which includes the header. The entry must be able to stand by itself. No freestanding items or items sitting on the table are allowed. Oversized folding displays will have 15 points deducted from the final score.
- 4. Both categories need to include works cited on the back of the entry. (example: Hoard's Dairyman 3/25/25 p. 275).
- 5. The entry form must be postmarked by May 1st. All entries must be in place no later than 7:30 p.m. on June 23, 2025, at the National Junior Holstein Convention. Entries should list name, category, title and age division on back. Youth members need not attend to participate.
- 6. Please select a mail service that will allow you to track your display. Late entries will not be judged.
- 7. Holstein Association USA staff reserves the right to reassign a display if it is entered in the wrong category.
- 8. It is the responsibility of each entrant to claim his or her entry on the final day of convention after the Junior Forum.
- 9. Cash awards will be presented in each division and category: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50 & 3rd \$25.
- 10. Contestants that have not placed first in a division may participate for as long as they are eligible for competition. First place winners are not eligible to compete again in the age and category division of which they have already won.
