Scott has been breeding and showing Ayrshire and Holstein cattle for 30 plus years. Watch-Hill Holsteins and Toll Gate Ayrshires are regularly exhibited at the Syracuse Spring Carousel, Eastern States Exposition and World Dairy Expo aside from the Eastern New York Holstein Show and the Connecticut State Holstein Show. Scott has an extra fondness for Eastern States Exposition (the Big E) having not missed a show since 1972 as his family has exhibited there since the hey-days of his grandfather Preston Davenport's Toll Gate Farm Ayrshires dating back into the 1940's. Personal highlights at the Big E for Scott would be winning Reserve Junior Champion Ayrshire in 1993 (Kellcrest Colleen3), Junior Champion Ayrshire in 2015 (Watch Hill Duncan Rita) and the multiple Herdsman's Canes he won in both the Ayrshire and Holstein shows throughout the years. Aside from his own heifer raising operation, he is heavily involved with his brother's Tollgate-Vu Holstein herd in Ancramdale, NY where the Watch-Hill milking herd is housed. A member of the 1995 University of Connecticut dairy judging team, Scott has been judging local and regional shows in New England and New York for 20 plus years and has served numerous times as an official for the Eastern States Intercollegiate Judging Contest. Scott has been employed as a scientist in drug safety research and development at Pfizer, Inc (Groton, Conn.) since 1997. Scott's wife Kimberlie breeds and shows Registered Quarter horses and the couple resides in Salem, Conn.
