Chris McCullough, of Juda, Wis., along with his wife Kathie, and children Rachel and Brian, operate Rock-N-Hill-II Holsteins where they farm 180 acres, milk 50 cows, and raise an additional 90 head of young stock. The rolling herd average is 23,286 pounds of milk, 920 fat and 729 protein. Chris has bred over 125 excellent cows in the 24 years RockN-Hill-II has been in existence. Of these, 15 cows have scored EX-94 or higher. The current BAA is 113.5% with 37 Excellent, 18 Very Good and 2 Good Plus cows.

Chris is no stranger to both the outside and the center of the showring. He bred and exhibited several district show champions, has earned Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor banners three times, and bred and exhibited the Intermediate Champion of the Wisconsin Championship Show and several All-Wisconsin and Reserve All-Wisconsin winners. He has also bred several cows that have earned Junior All-American nominations in 2012, 2013, and 2017.

As a judge, Chris has placed classes at the Wisconsin, Illinois, Minnesota, and Kentucky State Fairs. He has also judged at the Illinois and Iowa State Shows, the Wisconsin Jersey State Show twice, the Midwest Spring Red & White Show, Midwest Fall National Red & White Show, and the Western New York Spring Show. In 2018, he traveled to Quito, Ecuador to judge their Holstein, Brown Swiss, and Jersey shows. He has also served on All-American Judging Committees for Holstein, Jersey, Red & White and Ayrshire breeds.
